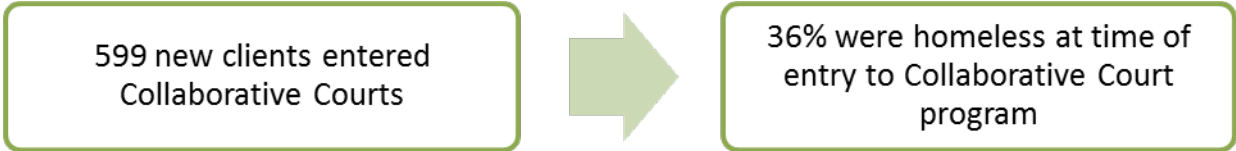




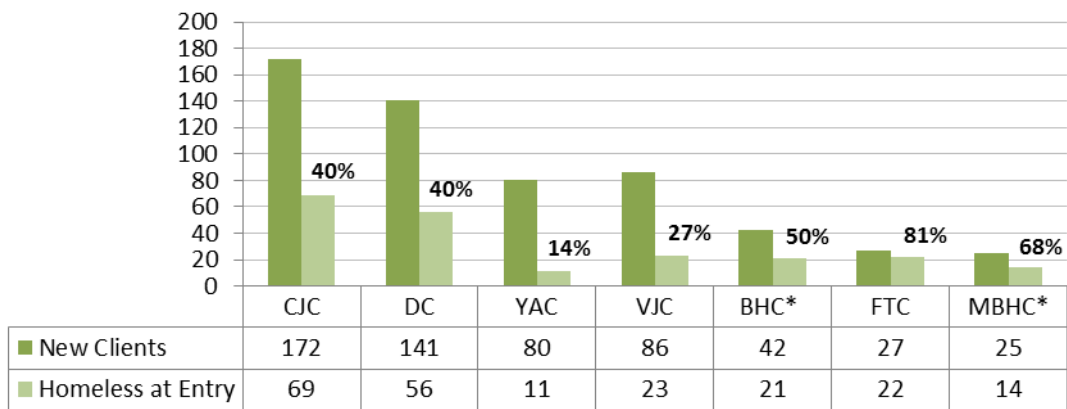

Homeless Clients in the San Francisco Collaborative Courts 2017

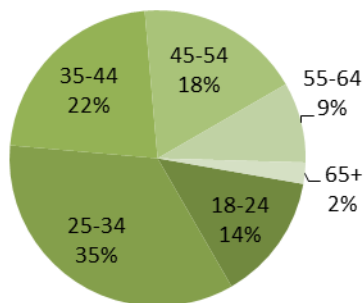


Homeless Clients by Court - 2017

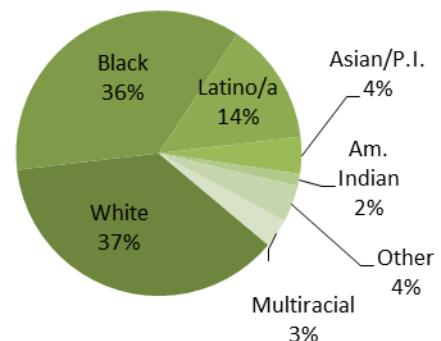


Eighty percent of all new Collaborative Court clients who were homeless at entry were Male. Nineteen percent were Female, 1% were Other.

Clients Homeless at Entry Age Range

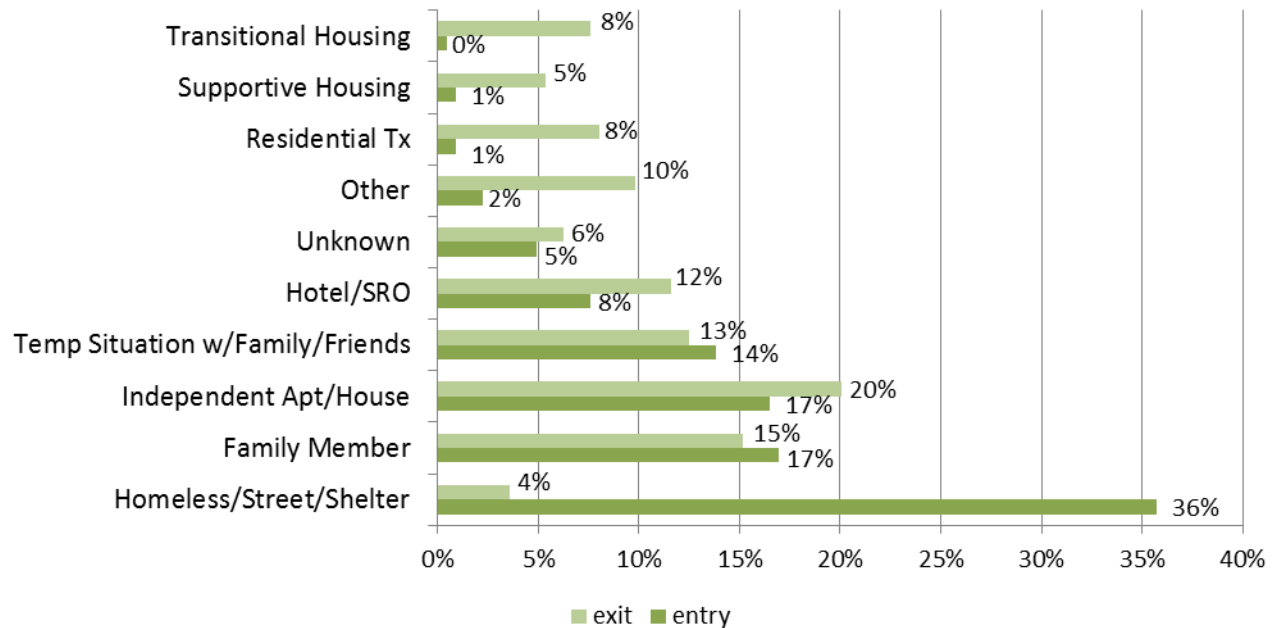


Clients Homeless at Entry Race

2017 Completed Clients - Living situation at entry and exit



36% of clients that **successfully completed** (n=224) a Collaborative Court in 2017 were homeless at entry, at exit 88% had housing, 8% were in Residential Treatment, and 4% were still homeless.

- 8 clients (4%) who successfully completed a Collaborative Court program in 2016 were homeless or living in a shelter upon exiting the program.
- 7 of these clients were homeless when starting the Community Justice Court program, 1 was living in an SRO (YAC participant).
