APPLICATION FOR SUSPENSION OF ACTIVE COLLECTION EFFORTS Government Code Section 25259.7

To the Presiding Judge of the San Francisco Superior Court:

The Comprehensive Collections Unit respectfully requests authority to suspend active collection efforts of court-ordered debt that it would otherwise be responsible for collecting. The request is based on one or more of the following:

- Collections efforts pursuant to the San Francisco Superior Court *Suspension of Active Collection Efforts of Court Ordered Debt Policy and Procedure* were followed and were unsuccessful in collecting payment.
- The amounts are too small to justify the cost of collection.
- The likelihood of collection does not warrant the expense involved.
- Other _____

Suspension of active collection efforts does not constitute a release of any person from liability for payment of any amount owed and does not apply to restitution.

Total amount requested to be suspended from active collection: \$73,452,188.91

Authority to Suspend Active Collections (Government Code Section 25259.9)

The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, having read and considered the information provided, determines that the request for suspension of collection is justified and relieves the applicant from any further responsibility for collecting the suspended debt. This suspension of collection does not constitute a release of any person from liability for payment of any amount owed and does not apply to restitution.

Further, suspension of collection will be a savings to the Court of \$680,000 in costs that would be incurred to maintain and keep these collection cases active.


The Clerk of the Court is directed to enter record of the suspended debt in the court case file for each debt and to post a copy of the order of suspended debt on the court's Internet Web Site for a period not less than three weeks.

Within 45 days after the end of the month in which this suspension is approved, the Superior Court shall report to the county the suspension from collection responsibility.
