

If you want to renew a restraining order or protective order issued by the San Francisco Superior Court following a hearing and the restraining or protective order is set to expire during the state of emergency declared by Gov. Gavin Newsom related to the COVID-19 pandemic, your restraining order is **automatically** extended for up to 90 days from the date of expiration pursuant to California Emergency Rule of Court 8. Before the 90 days expires, the protected party must file a request that the court renew the restraining order using the Judicial Council forms.
