2019 FELONY & MISDEMEANOR BAIL SCHEDULE (July 1, 2019)

The following bail schedule is promulgated under the mandate of Penal Code section 1269(c).

For all unscheduled **felonies**, the bail amount is **\$15,000**. For all unscheduled **misdemeanors**, the bail amount is **\$3,000**. For all unscheduled **infractions**, the bail amount is **\$100**. NOTE: All attempts of an offense (whether listed as "attempt," "att," or "664") have the same bail amount as the offense itself.

NOTE: "#" indicates that bail amount applies to all subsections of the listed statute, or subsection, unless subsection is listed with different bail. Offenses subject to P.C. Section 1270.1 are marked in this schedule with a single asterisk (*)

Attached at the end of this schedule are two conversion charts related to Penal Code weapon offenses. The first table is the conversion from the old statute to the current section. The second table is the conversion from new statutes to the old. The intention of this bail schedule is to set bail based on the current statute. In the event that the old statute is referenced in the booking process, you are to set the higher bail based on these conversion tables, and NOT to set bail as a default.

Setting Bail: When more than one offense is charged, or there is more than one victim please follow the attached guidelines. Bail should be set based on available information.

Setting Bail:

Two or More Charges:

- Two or more charges arising from the same course of conduct on the same occasion—set bail for the charge having the highest bail.

- EXAMPLE: This example demonstrates how to calculate bail when a defendant is booked on more than one charge arising out of a single act.

- Charge 1 Penal Code section 245(a)(1) assault with a deadly weapon \$75,000

- Charge 2 Penal Code section 243(d) battery with serious injury \$50,000

- Charge 3 Penal Code section 203 mayhem \$60,000

- The bail in this example is \$75,000 because Penal Code section 245(a)(1) carries the highest bail and all the charges arise from a single act.

- Two more charges arising from separate courses of conduct—set bail for the charge in each course of conduct having the highest bail.

- EXAMPLE: This example demonstrates how to calculate bail when a defendant is booked on more than one charge arising from different acts.

- Charge 1 Vehicle Code section 10851 vehicle theft

- Charge 2 Vehicle Code section 20001(b) hit/run
