GENERAL MEETING SUMMARY

May 17, 2016

Ten (10) Commissioners attended the May 17, 2016 general meeting of the San Francisco Juvenile Justice Commission (JJC).

- On the date of the Commission meeting, the Youth Guidance Center population was 7 girls and 30 boys. There were 14 boys at the Log Cabin Ranch.
- The Commission presented the 2016 San Francisco Juvenile Justice Commission Awards for Community Service to recipients Jeremy Tom (JT), who works with the Hunters Point Families, and United Playaz. Misha Olivas accepted the award on behalf of United Playaz.
- The Commission had their annual inspection of the Juvenile Justice Center in the month of May.
- The graduation event will be at Elks Lodge on Monday, May 23rd. Three Commissioners will attend.
- Mrs. Hernandez shared that one youth at Log Cabin Ranch, who will soon turn 19
 years old, received a scholarship at the City Now Gala for college. His financial aid
 was established and he will be moving into a college dormitory.
- The Juvenile Justice Center school break begins Friday, May 27th through June 3rd.
 Director Recinos invited probation offers to work with the youth outside of school during this time.
